


The Mobile Sculpture Workshop, a community outreach program of The Industrial Arts Cooperative, is a summer workshop aimed at sharing the techniques of safe and proper welding and metal fabrication while producing a large-scale sculpture for public display.

A work-in-progress sculpture will travel to 12 community events and festivals throughout the summer of 2015. Apprentices will demonstrate live sculpture making and creative process at events throughout the city. These sites will offer one-on-one training opportunities to learn professional techniques in welding and metal fabrication. We are looking for qualified students with recommendations from local sponsors (teachers, mentors, community groups). Selections will be based on individual interests and needs. At the sculpture's completion, students will also be paid a modest stipend as collaborators for their participation in the project.

What is the Industrial Arts Co-op?

At the heart of the Industrial Arts Cooperative is a commitment to serve the creative needs of its people through community outreach and collaboration. It is the mission of the IAC to inspire artistic literacy in the city of Pittsburgh by offering enrichment opportunities that advance the understanding and process of sculpture making artists and their work.
