Position Description

Rivers of Steel Tour Guides are engaging, informed, and enthusiastic individuals who provide interpretive, guided experiences for public and private groups. Guides report to the Manager of Tourism and Receptive Services, and work in partnership with our administrative, education and historic resources departments. Guides work with site coordinators, facilities managers and educational staff regularly.

Guides will lead new and existing in- house tours of Rivers of Steel's sites including the Carrie Furnaces National Historic Landmark, the Battle of Homestead Site, the Bost Building National Historic Landmark, all in Allegheny County, and the W.A. Young & Sons Foundry and Machine Shop National Historic Landmark in Greene County. Additionally, guides will narrate public tours and provide interpretive support for programs on the newly acquired RiverQuest *Explorer*, a 94-foot ship that sails Pittsburgh's rivers. Guides also have the opportunity to fulfill a host role, providing customer service at signature events.

Please note: *While guides are needed for the various sites at times, the predominant roles as a tour guide will be for sightseeing tours on the boat and for the Carrie Blast Furnace tour. Opportunities to guide at additional locations will be based on experience and interest. Paid training is provided.*

Requirements

This position requires a dynamic personality with enthusiasm for the history and culture of southwestern Pennsylvania. Guides are expected to enjoy working with the public and work well in a team environment. The ability to work weekends and holidays is essential.

Guides are expected to attend all meetings and trainings, including those related to content, safety, customer service, etc.

Guides are required to master tour content and equipment, including audio/visual and point-of-sale systems. Duties vary by tour location.

Qualifications

Guides should have strong communication skills and the ability to speak effectively and confidently in front of an audience. This includes the ability to inform and engage guests / tourists as an articulate, energetic presenter and to deliver exceptional customer service.

Guides should have the ability to interact comfortably with people of diverse backgrounds and interests. This position requires a positive attitude, teamwork and dedication to the service of Rivers of Steel's clients and guests.

Previous experience as a tour guide, docent or educator is preferred. Candidates with customer service experience will be considered.

Previous tourism experience and knowledge of Pittsburgh's and southwestern Pennsylvania's, cultural and historic attractions and visitor attractions is a plus.

Physical requirements include the ability to move freely throughout the *Explorer* vessel, walk across uneven terrain at the Carrie Furnaces site, and accompanying motor coach groups on and off buses.

B.A. or B.S. from an accredited college or university is preferred.

Guides must have Act 33/34 and FBI clearances. Guides for *Explorer* may also be subject to a pre-employment drug screen and be included in a subsequent random drug screen pool.

Rivers of Steel offers a dynamic, lifelong learning environment. Additional opportunities exist to assist with research, program preparation and development, along with teaching opportunities for educational groups. Tour guides are a valuable and esteemed addition to our team, and the work environment is collegial and stimulating.
